Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is one of the most authoritative and widely recognized non-examination high school diplomas in the world. The OSSD is issued by the provincial Ontario Ministry of Education and granted upon completion of diploma requirements.

The OSSD is officially recognized by all top universities in the world and enjoys a high status in the global k-12 education system. This means that holding an OSSD can satisfy the dream of a top university worldwide.

Main Advantages of Earning an OSSD

1. Avoid extreme pressures of passing a national exit exam.
2. Students with a minimum of six Grade 12 credits are eligible to apply to universities worldwide.
3. The standard assessment is based on 70% term work, 30% final assessment.
4. Students from other provinces in Canada or countries can seamlessly transfer credits towards the OSSD.

How to Obtain an OSSD?

1. Successfully complete 30 credits, including 18 compulsory credits and 12 elective credits.
2. Complete 40 hours of community service.
3. Pass the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) or successfully complete the Ontario Secondary Literacy Course (OSSLC).

BEST PATH

TO Top Universities Worldwide

The Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) is recognized worldwide as an entrance requirement for universities around the world. Brooklyn graduates are qualified to seek direct admission to undergraduate programs in at universities in **Canada, USA, UK, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore or Hong Kong etc.**



Canada

All students, both Canadian and international, who hold an OSSD, are considered equally for admission to all Canadian universities.



UK

Students who hold an OSSD are not required to attend preparatory and A-Level exams for admission to UK universities.



Australia / New Zealand

For most of Top 8 universities in Australia, students are not required to show evidence of IELTS proficiency if they hold an OSSD.



USA

The US and Canada have similar education systems. OSSD holders have high rates of acceptance to American universities, and in some instances, no SAT is required.

Use OSSD Grade 12 English to apply directly to prestigious schools instead of IELTS/TOEFL



Asia



Students who hold an OSSD are not required to complete university entrance examinations. Students are not required to submit their IELTS if they have obtained grade 12 English credit with a score of 70-80+.

GRADE 9-12 OSSD PROGRAMS

Students can join the Grade 9 to 12 OSSD program at any intake in a year to meet the needs of different school systems around the world, as well as to shorten their time to graduate. 8-10 credits per year are recommended. There are five intakes in a year.

INTENSIVE ESL PROGRAM

ESL (English as a Second Language Program) is mandatory for students whose English proficiency level is below the academic requirement in the Ontario Secondary School Curriculum. After the student successfully completes ESLEO, he or she can directly move to the academic English courses.

Entrance Placement Test

Students are required to take the placement test to determine their English proficiency level. Students below the academic requirements are required to take ESL courses.

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION PROGRAM

Students who aim to apply for the Prestigious Universities worldwide need to earn at least 6 Grade 12 courses and * 2 additional courses (depends on students' English proficiency) with the help of guidance from Brooklyn.

"Top Six" refers to six senior Grade 12 OSSD U/M courses that are averaged to determine your admission average by Universities. Top Six average is based on a combination of required and elective courses and your individual admission average varies from school to school, and even program to program.
