2. Pay application fee	Application fee is \$300 Canadian dollars (5% handling fee for international credit cards)
3. Submit relevant materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Application form 2. School transcripts from Grade 9 onwards 3. Junior high school, high school diploma or highest academic qualification (scan or copy) 4. Proof of enrollment 5. Language scores (if provided) 6. Passport homepage (scanned copy)
4. School evaluates student materials	<p>A. School evaluates the academic qualifications completed by the applicant (based on the grade and grade level the student has completed then the credits that the student can transfer are evaluated)</p> <p>B. U15+ elite classes, U15+Top3 elite classes or gifted classes for top 100 elite schools can apply for video interviews.</p>
5. Notification of admission from the school	After reviewing the student's materials, if the materials are complete and qualified, the school will issue Pre-admission and invoice to notify the student to pay the tuition fee.
6. The school issues an letter of acceptance	After the school receives the student's full tuition, the school will issue a tuition receipt and a Letter of Acceptance.
7. Apply for guardianship	When applying for a visa, students under the age of 18 must apply for guardianship, which costs 1,200 Canadian dollars per year.
8. Apply for study visa	The applicant prepares the required documents according to the visa document list, notarizes them, and submits them to the embassy to apply for a study visa in Canada.

* The school will conduct an English proficiency test for each student, assess the ESL level based on the test results, and notify the student to pay the ESL tuition fee
