	After the school receives the student's full tuition, the school will issue a
letter of acceptance	tuition receipt and a Letter of Acceptance.
	When applying for a visa, students under the age of 18 must apply for guardianship, which costs 1,200 Canadian dollars per year.
	The applicant prepares the required documents according to the visa document
	list, notarizes them, and submits them to the embassy to apply for a study visa in Canada.
